About NYSERDA

- New York's state energy office
- Mission is to advance innovative energy solutions in ways that improve New York's economy and environment.
- Spent over \$67 million on transportation deployment programs since 1996

Future Opportunity: NYC Private Fleet Program

- Funding available mid-2011
- Vehicles must travel primarily within NYC
- Medium- and Heavy-duty EVs (and other AFVs) eligible
- Incentives for 50-80% of incremental cost
- Previous EV projects:
 - Frito-Lay: 5 Smith Electric Edisons plus charging stations
 - Down East Seafoods: 1 Smith Electric Faraday Mark II
 - New Deal Logistics: 2 Smith Electric Newton plus charging station

Future Opportunity: US DOE Clean Cities

- Solicitation expected early 2011
- NYSERDA will likely apply for funding under competitive program on behalf of partners
- EVs will likely be eligible for funding at the funding level DOE sets
- Previous projects:
 - \$13.3 million in projects from previous solicitation, including EVs, CNG, hybrids, and EV charging stations

Future Opportunity: Transportation & Climate Initiative

- 11-state group of energy, environment, and transportation agencies (Maryland to Maine)
- Developing a plan for a network of charging stations across the Northeast
- Working with partners to implement pilot projects
- Looking for funding and partners to work on this major initiative
